CLASS 8 -- TOBACCO STALKS

Exhibits shall consist of one stalk of tobacco. Judged on size, quality, and soundness of leaf. Must be grown by exhibitor.

CLASS 9 -- FIELD CORN – SIX EAR EXHIBIT

LOT

- 01 – Yellow Hybrid 02 – White Hybrid

CLASS 10 -- HAY IN ½ SIZED BALES

Must be grown in current year. Must be grown by exhibitor.

LOT

- 01 – ½ bale Grass Hay 02 – ½ bale Grass-Clover Mixed

CLASS 11 -- GARDEN VEGETABLES

All varieties in this list should be shown in best condition for table use. Mere size is not the most necessary quality in okra, squash, beans, etc. Exhibitors allowed only one entry per lot. All vegetables must be grown by exhibitor.

- 01 – Garden Display: consist of no less than 8 varieties of garden vegetables arranged in decorative manner.
 - 02 – Five (5) White Onions
 - 03 – Five (5) Yellow Onions
 - 04 – Three (3) Acorn Squash
 - 05 – One (1) Sugar Pie Pumpkin
 - 06 – Ten (10) Pods Okra (table size)
 - 07 – Five (5) Hot Peppers
 - 08 – Five (5) Sweet Peppers
 - 09 – Three (3) Winter Squash
 - 10 – Six (6) Sweet Potatoes

CLASS 12 -- MAMMOTH VEGETABLES

Exhibits in this class are for exhibition purposes and are not intended to display commercial qualities of vegetables and fruits represented. Each class will be judged on size or dimension indicated. Entries must be grown by exhibitor.

 - 02 – Cushaw (largest by weight)
 - 03 – Irish Potato (largest by weight)
 - 04 – Sweet Potato (largest by weight)

CLASS 13 -- EGGS

- LOT
- 01 – White Eggs (one dozen)
 - 02 – Brown Eggs (one dozen)

HONEY

1. All entries must be produced by exhibitor.
2. Honey will only be accepted in clear glass, large-mouth quart size jars.
3. All jars must be labeled.
4. Only one entry per lot per exhibitor.
5. Only two entries per lot per family.
