

UNION COUNTY HERITAGE FESTIVAL
STUDENT ART EXHIBIT and CONTEST
SATURDAY, OCTOBER 7, 2017

The Annual Student Art Exhibit will again be featured as part of the Union County Heritage Festival. Art works created by students in sixth through twelfth grades will be exhibited at the Snodderly House (near First Baptist Church) on Main Street in Maynardville. All sixth through twelfth grade students, including homeschool students, are eligible to enter.

Any type of two dimensional media (painting, drawing, collage, acrylic, pencil, charcoal, color, black and white, etc) will be eligible for display. Three dimensional pieces such as pottery, wood and metal construction, and other materials may be entered. Art items should be no larger than **16 by 20 inches in size**. Students may enter two items of varied media, and all items must be labeled on the back. Art should be labeled with full name printed legibly, grade level, title of item, and a phone number or other way to reach the student if the student does not attend Union County schools.

Entries will be collected from the Horace Maynard Middle School and Union County High School by Student Art Chairperson on Thursday, September 29th. Other entries can be delivered to the Union County UT Agricultural Extension Office on Maynardville Highway by 3:30pm on September 29th.

Ribbons will be awarded for Best of Show, Best Heritage Item, First, Second, Third Places, and Honorable Mention. Art items should be picked up at the Snodderly House by 4:30pm on October 7th. Art items entered by UC school students which are not picked up at the end of the festival will be delivered to the schools during the week after the Festival.
