

HERITAGE FESTIVAL PIE BAKING CONTEST



★ Rules ★

1. Pie must be entered in the name of the person who made it. Contestant may only enter one pie in each category, for a maximum of three pies. **OPEN TO ALL AGES, NO ENTRY FEE.**

2. Categories

- i. Fruit
- ii. Nut
- iii. Other

3. Prizes

- a. Grand Prize = \$100 and a ribbon
- b. Each category
 - i. 1st = \$50 and a ribbon
 - ii. 2nd = ribbon
 - iii. 3rd = ribbon

Prizes have graciously been donated by Steve Thompson of BSG Solutions.

4. Enter Pie

- a. Bring your pie to the UT Extension Office—Union County (3925 Maynardville Highway) on Friday, October 6, 2017 from 8 AM to 5 PM. The person running the Pie Baking Contest will have the final say on acceptability of pies.
- b. Fill out the registration form.
 - i. Acknowledge that the entered pies become the property of the Heritage Festival and that you do not get your pie or pie pan back.
 - ii. If you are a winner, you give your permission to have your photo taken during the announcement ceremony and have it used for Heritage Festival promotional materials.
- c. All contest entrants will receive a Heritage Festival ribbon.
- d. All contest entrants must provide a recipe for their pie (s).

5. Judging
 - a. Judging will be held at the office Friday, October 6, 2017 in the evening.
 - b. Minimum of three judges
 - c. Criteria
 - i. Overall appearance
 - ii. Crust
 - iii. Taste
 - d. Scoring
 - i. Each judge assigns a numerical value (1-10) in each criteria category, without consultation with the other judges.
 - ii. The pie receiving the highest total numerical value is the winner in that category.
 - iii. In the case of a tie, the judges will judge those pies again.
 - iv. Grand Prize winner
 1. Each 1st Prize winning pie will be judged again.
 2. Judges will decide which pie is the Grand Prize Pie.
 - v. In the category of the Grand Prize winning pie (Fruit, Nut, or Other), the 2nd Place pie will become the 1st, the 3rd Place becomes 2nd, and the 4th becomes 3rd.
 - e. Winners will be announced the day of the Heritage Festival October 7, 2017.
6. Disposition of Pies
 - a. All pies will be sold per slice at the 4-H concession booth during the Heritage Festival.
 - b. All proceeds from the sale of pies will be used by the UT Extension Union County to fund its many activities and services.
 - c. Grand Prize Pie will be auctioned off through a silent auction the day of the Heritage Festival.
