Deadlines [spaces usually sell out before September 5]

- **September 5-Applications with payment received by this date will appear on the website and in the newspaper program.**
- **September 15 or 'til full-Application and payment received by this date to participate.**
- **No booth will be assigned nor will a confirmation be sent until payment is made.**

Booth Awards

- Rocky Top Award is for the booth that best embodies the spirit and theme of the Festival. In addition, the following may be awarded: Best Heritage, Best Demonstration, and Merit Awards for particular items of distinction.

Set-Up and Security

- Booths may be set-up from 12:00 PM to 7PM on the Friday before the Festival (September 30)
- and from 7:00 AM to 9:00 AM on Festival Day (October 2). **The Festival opens at 10:00 AM and closes at 4:00 PM. All vehicles must be removed from the vender area by 9:00 AM and shall not return until after 4:00 PM.** Booths are to be set-up and open during these hours. Security will be on site from 6:00 PM Friday to the close of the Festival. Emergency personnel are on hand the day of the Festival. Each booth space will have one Vendor Parking Permit issued if not raining at check-in.
