## **No Stakes on Pavement**

Use sand buckets, bricks, cinder blocks, or pvc and concrete weights on the pavement.

Saturday, October 7, from 7:00AM to 9:00AM Please pull to the right and leave the left lane clear. Please drop your articles and move your vehicle within moments. Festival volunteers will help unload.
